

**School Spirit Expectations at Newport High School Athletic/Activity Events
2009-10**

Being an ASB cardholder or purchasing a ticket to any high school athletic event does not give a person freedom to act as they wish. The event host can have outlined behavior expectations that they may administer and enforce. They are only required to provide the event that was paid for, provide an opportunity to view that event and to provide any medical care should it be necessary.

The following are the behavior expectations at Newport High School for **2009-10** school year, for both home and away contests. These are aligned with the Washington Interscholastic Activities Association's (WIAA) "Just Play Fair" guidelines on sportsmanship expectations of member schools. Newport High School is a WIAA member school and subscribes to the policies and procedures of "Just Play Fair".



Spectators (Students, Parents and Visitors):

- Respect Officials – No personal or derogatory comments directed at them.
- Respect Opponents – No personal or derogatory comments directed at opposition players, coaches or students.
- No profanity. No inappropriate cheers or comments.
- Students will be expected to be respectful of event supervisors at all contests and abide by all KingCo Conference and W.I.A.A. event guidelines.

*******Behavior Contract*******

Failure to adhere to the behavior expectations will result in one or more of the following discipline steps being enforced.

Step #1 – Discuss guidelines and have spectator sign this contract for remainder of their career at Newport High School. Discuss and make sure the spectator knows and understands Step #2 consequences. Provide spectator with a copy of their signed contract. **Contact parent/guardian and notify them of student's status.**

Step #2 – Spectator will be refused admittance to home and away contests involving Newport High School **up to the remainder of the current sports season.** Discuss and make sure spectator knows and understands Step #3 consequences. **Contact parent/guardian and notify them of student's status.**

Step #3 - Spectator will be refused admittance to home and away contests involving Newport High School **up to the remainder of the current school year (2009-10).** Discuss and make sure spectator knows and understands this is the final action and step for the remainder of the school year (2009-10). **Contact parent/guardian and notify them of student's status.**

Note: Returning students who have been placed on Step 1-3, will start the following year on Step 1 and will be reminded at the beginning of the school year of these expectations.
