

KABA Sports Concessions Guidelines and Procedures

Overall:

Concessions for all athletic events at Newport High School now fall under the domain of the Knight Athletic Booster Association (KABA). Annually there will be a signed agreement between KABA and Newport High School ASB for providing this service.

Allocating Concessions:

By a vote of KABA members it was decided that when allocating events that the sport involved would have first right to concessions for those contests. Example: Football Boosters will have first right to all home football game concessions.

If the host sport is not interested in providing concessions or taking on the responsibility it will then go to the large group to decide amongst the remaining members who those contests will be allocated to.

Financial Breakdown:

Here is an outline of how the funds generated by a KABA sponsored concession stand will be divided.

5% - KABA

5% - Store Manager

50% - Store Fund – Invoices and Supplies

Note: If any machinery needs to be purchased or replaced it will be the responsibility of KABA to provide funds for this. It has also been determined that if the Store Fund ever achieves a large surplus, that extra monies would be deferred back to the groups involved.

40% - Individual Group Working that Event

Current Concessions Status:

Fall:

Football = Gridiron Club

Jr. Knights Football – Jr. Knights

Miscellaneous Events = Jr. Knights

Winter:

Currently concessions are left to the individual sport booster club to provide and do not fall under this set of guidelines.

Spring:

Track & Field = Track & Field Boosters
